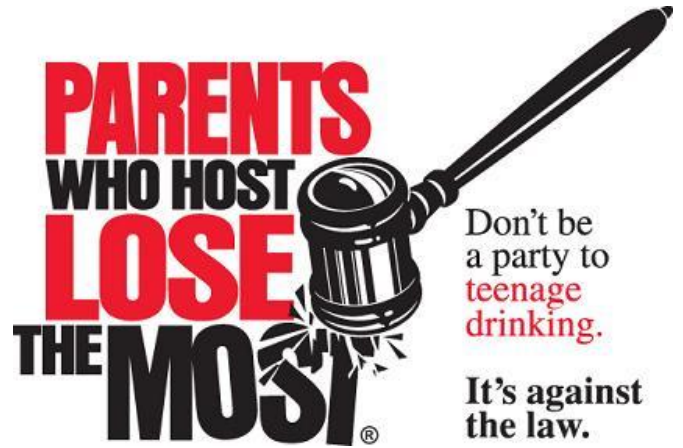




Communities That Care of Bradford County

“A person commits a misdemeanor of the third degree if he intentionally or knowingly sells or furnishes, or purchases with the intent to sell or furnish, any liquor or malt or brewed beverages to a person who is less than 21 years of age.

It could cost you anywhere from \$1,000 to \$2500 per offense and 0-1 year in jail.

Youth like to be in the majority and the majority of the youth in Bradford and Sullivan County do not use alcohol or other drugs.

In 2011 the Pennsylvania youth Survey indicated that 74% of tenth grade students and 62% of seniors had not drank alcohol in the past 30 days

Majority is the place to be for the youth in our county. Talk to your kids and make sure they are part of the majority.
