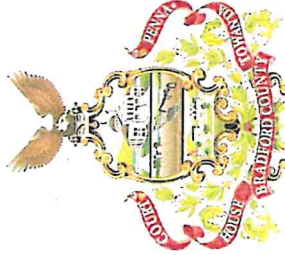

RESOLUTION 2022-01

A resolution of the county of Bradford, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, supporting the Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial (AMERICA250PA)

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania legislature and Governor created AMERICA250PA in 2018 to plan, encourage, develop and coordinate the commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the United States and Pennsylvania's integral role in that event and the role of its people on the nation's past, present and future;

WHEREAS, AMERICA250PA hopes to engage ALL Pennsylvanians and ALL 67 counties through their many signature and officially recognized programs, projects and events over the next five years by inspiring future leaders and celebrating all Pennsylvanians contributions to the nation over the last 250 years;

WHEREAS, by adoption of AMERICA250PA's four pillars of EPIC, we hope to educate, preserve, innovate, and celebrate.

RESOLVED, Bradford County officially establishes an AMERICA250PA County Commission made up of a diverse group of citizens to work with AMERICA250PA on any and all activities within Bradford County. The participants of the Bradford County Commission will be strictly voluntary roles and there will be no compensation for participation.

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Bradford County legislative delegation and AMERICA250PA Commission.

A CONTINUATION OF THE MINUTES OF JANUARY 25, 2022

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by Commissioner McLinko, all voted “aye” to authorizing the Chief Clerk to legally advertise setting the date, time and location of the Bradford County Prison Board meetings. The meetings will be held at 11:00 am on the second Thursday of the month except for holidays, in the Commissioner’s office located in the Bradford County Courthouse with quarterly meetings being held at the Prison.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by Commissioner McLinko, all voted “aye” to approving the grant agreement between Bradford County and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency awarding Bradford County with two hundred seven thousand seven hundred and forty-two dollars (\$207,742.00) of 2021 9-1-1 Statewide Interconnectivity Funding.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by Commissioner McLinko, all voted “aye” to approving the Certificate of County Funds for 2022 program year in the amount of ten thousand two hundred forty-seven dollars and twenty-three cents (\$10,247.23) to purchase agricultural conservation easements.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by Commissioner McLinko, all voted “aye” to approving the agreement between Bradford County and Patrick Lee Beirne, Esq to serve as a contracted Attorney for the Public Defender office at the rate of forty-five dollars (\$45.00), not to exceed fifteen hours per week after his retirement effective March 8, 2022.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by Commissioner McLinko, all voted “aye” to approving the renewal of an agreement between Thompson Law Office and Bradford County Planning Commission for solicitor services at a fee of nine thousand six hundred dollars \$9,600.00 annually effective February 1, 2022 thru January 31, 2023.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by Commissioner McLinko, all voted “aye” to approving the amended unit of service funding contract between Bradford and Sullivan County Joinder and Allied Services effective January 1, 2022 thru June 30, 2022.


