IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO RETURN YOUR VOTED MAIL-IN BALLOT BY THE DEADLINE, YOU MAY ONLY VOTE A PROVISIONAL BALLOT AT YOUR POLLING PLACE ON ELECTION DAY, UNLESS YOU SURRENDER YOUR MAIL-IN BALLOT AND THE RETURN ENVELOPE CONTAINING THE VOTER'S DECLARATION TO THE JUDGE OF ELECTIONS TO BE VOIDED TO VOTE BY REGULAR BALLOT.
